3. UPDATE ON NSHE TUITION GUARANTEE E
WORKING GROUPINFORMATION ONLY

At its June 78, 2018 meeting the Nevada Board of Regents charged NSHE Chancellor Thom Reilly to return to a future meeting with a tuition guarantee policy proposal for the Board's consideration. Chancellor Reilly, with input from the institutional presidents, appointed a systemwide working group to be led by NSHE Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs Crystal Abba. Vice Chancellor Abba will provide an update to NSA members on the discussions and proposals to date of the Chancellor's ad hoc Tuition Guarantee Working Group.
