# 5. REVISIONS TO THE NEVADA STUDENT ALLIANCE CONSTITUTION

## FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

NSA members will consider the approval of an amendment to the NSA constitution that adds the Associated Students of the University of Nevada School of Medicine (ASUNSOM) to the membership of the Nevada Student Alliance. Additionally, revisions to the NSA constitution include clarifying language concerning the votes required for the election of officers and for impeachment of a member. The proposed amendments were first presented for information at the September 7, 2023, NSA meeting.

Amendment will require a two-thirds vote of all voting members (Attached Ref. NSA-5)

Chair Stankute introduces the item. She explains she will ask for a motion, and a second and then will
