2. Approved – Employment Contract, Head Football Coach, UNLV Agenda Item #2 – The Board approved a multi-year employment agreement for Mr. Tony Sanchez UNLV's Head Football Coach. The terms and conditions of the agreement were presented and discussed at the meeting. (Ref. BOR2a, Ref. BOR2b, Ref. BOR2c, Ref. BOR2d and Handout 2n file in the Board Office).

Mr. Donald D. Snyder, President, University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) this is a very big day. UNLV felt it best to conduct the search for the next UNLV Head Football Coach quickly and thoroughly. Mr. Sanchez was the unanimous choice.

Ms. KunzerMurphy highlighted key elements of the contract. This is a four year contract effective December 2014 through December 2018. She explained the annual base compensation is \$500,000 and there is an opportunity to earn additional compensation of up to \$50,000 annually and additional supplemental compensation as specified in the contract. She stated the proposed contract protects UNLV in several ways specifically outlined in the contract.
