- 1. <u>Information Only Public Comment</u> Ms. Dana Trimble, Faculty Senate Chair, Desert Research Institute (DRI), said the DRI Faculty Senate supports a national/international search and an external candidate for DRI's acting president. She stated the Faculty Senate strongly supports the recommendation of Dr. Robert B. Gagosian as the acting president of DRI.
 - Dr. J. Kyle Dalpe, President, Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC), thanked the Board for the opportunity to serve as acting president and welcomed Dr. Karin Hilgersom to TMCC on behalf of the college.
- 2. <u>Approved Appointment, President, TMCC</u> The Board approved the appointment of the ad hoc TMCC President Search Committee's recommendation of Dr. Karin Hilgersom as President of Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC) and the salary and contract terms as amended with a start date of June 15, 2016, contingent upon a review of Dr. Hilgersom's background check by the Chancellor and the Vice Chancellor for Legal Affairs (Refs. BOR2a throughBOR2e on file in the Board office).

Regent Melcher moved approval of the appointment of Dr. Karin Hilgersom as the President of Truckee Meadows Community College and approval of the salary and contract terms as presented. Regent Geddes seconded.

Regent Melcher thanked President Dalpe for his leadership as the acting president at TMCC and for his assistance with the search process; Ms. Marti J. Cizek, President, Cizek Associates, Inc., for a pleasant and comprehensive search process with 46 initial candidates and four strong, final candidates; and Mr. Dean J. Gould, Chief of Staff and Special Counsel to the Board of Regents, Ms. Brooke A. Nielsen, Vice Chancellor, Legal Aff, 2h [(H)2 (i)-2 (l)-2 (ge)4 ((d)le(,)lT.(B)0.6 (O)3Drp(r)-1 (m)-6)4 (nt)-2 ft4524 (l)-2 (s)-1 (e)1 (e)1

and recommended a change to the July 1, 2016, start date to June 15, 2016. The three-year contract terms include a \$200,000 annual base salary and automobile, housing and host allowances. Chancellor Klaich said he will be approving certain moving and relocation expenses as provided for in Board Policy. He said he also approved one trip for Dr. Hilgersom and her spouse to visit Reno prior to her start date. He noted that Ms. Cizek said the civil and criminal background check came back clean; however, he is requesting that the motion be contingent upon his review of the background check with Vice Chancellor Nielsen.

Regents Melcher and Geddes amended the motion to include a revised start date of June 15, 2016, and contingent upon a review of the background check by the Chancellor and the Vice Chancellor for Legal Affairs.

Regent Stephens thanked Chancellor Klaich for his presentation of the contract terms.

Motion carried. Regent Leavitt was absent.

Dr. Hilgersom thanked the Board and expressed her excitement about TMCC. She is looking forward to working with the Regents and the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) to advance the transformative and important work of community college higher education.

Chairman Trachok reopened public comment (Agenda iten#1).

Mr. Mike Benjamin, DRI Foundation Trustee, and Ms. Stephanie Tyler, DRI Foundation Vice Chair, thanked the Board for the opportunity to be involved in the search process and spoke in support of Dr. Robert B. Gagosian.

3. <u>Approved – Acting President and Presidential Transition, DRI</u> – The Board approved the appointment of Dr. Robert B. Gagosian as the acting president of the Desert Research Institute (DRI) and approved the contract and terms as presented (Refs. BOR3athroughBOR3d on file in the Board office

Chancellor Klaich, after consultation with Chairman Trachok, recommended approval of Dr. Gagosian as the acting president of DRI. Chancellor Klaich reviewed the information regarding campus visits included in his April 25, 2016, memorandum submitted to the Board. It is clear the campus wanted a national/international search and an outside president for acting president. Two very strong candidates emerged in the process and

Chancellor Klaich said he is very excited about the recommendation of Dr. Robert B. Gagosian as the acting president of DRI. Dr. Gagosian is a scientist of international renown and respect. The contract terms include a salary recommendation of \$275,000 and automobile, housing and host allowances and no merit or cost of living adjustments. The contract term is one year or upon the hiring of a permanent president.

Regent Lieberman moved approval of the appointment of Dr. Robert B. Gagosian as the acting president of the Desert Research Institute and approved the contract and terms as presented. Regent Geddes seconded. Motion carried. Regent Leavitt was absent.
