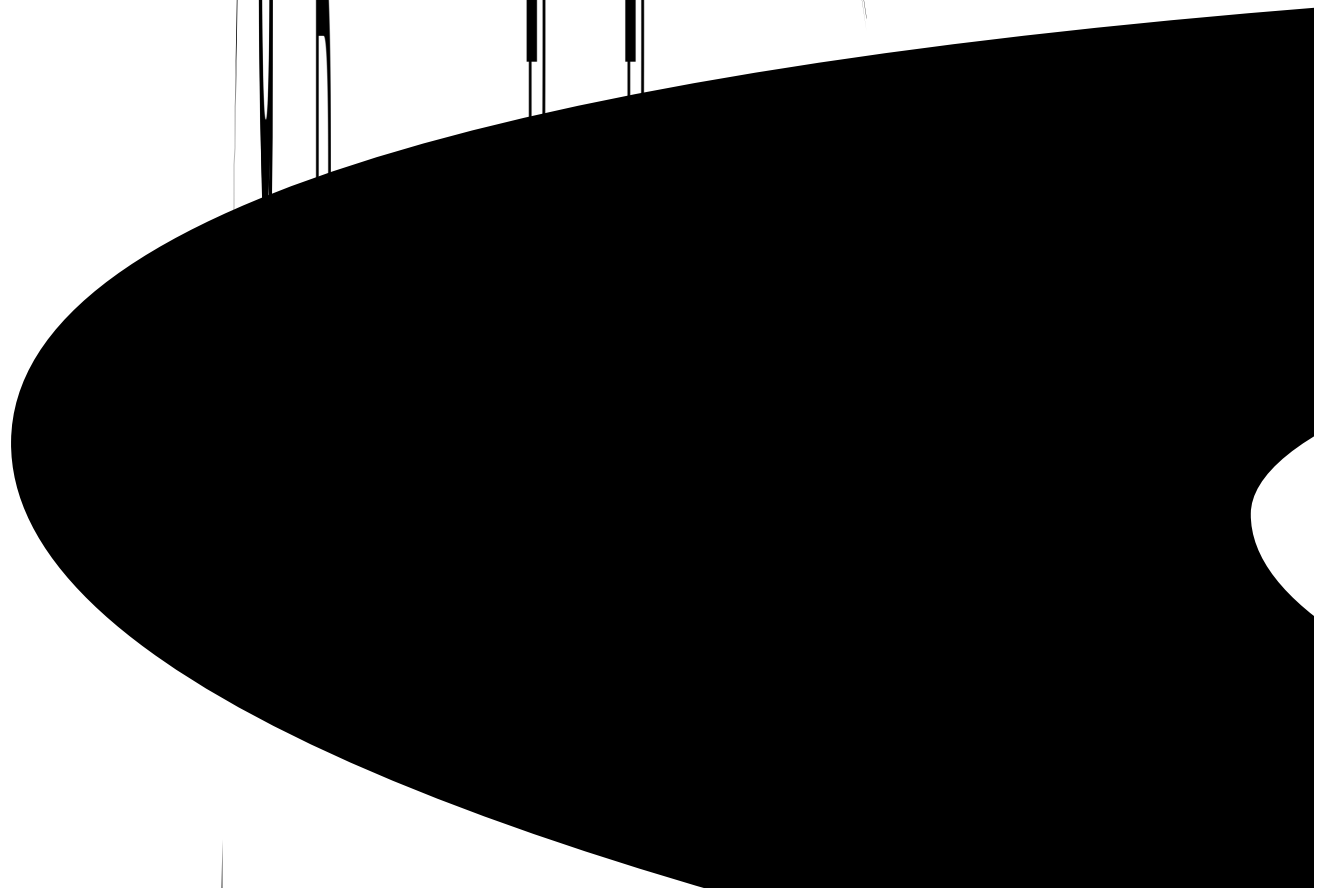
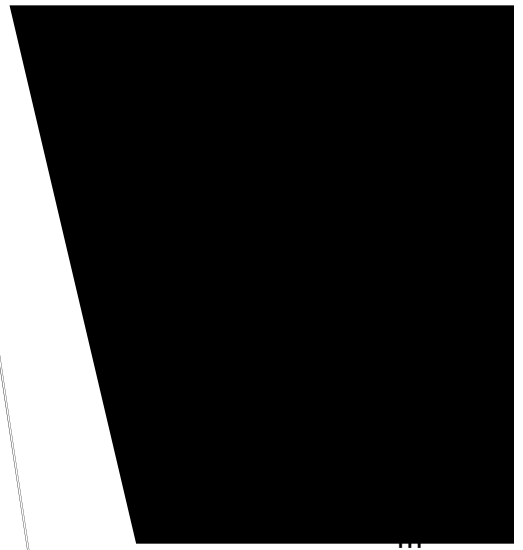


matters coming under his control. These resolutions shall take effect and be in force on and after the beginning of the Fall term of 1891.
