The recessed meeting of the Board was called to order at 10:30
on May 9th.

Present: Regents Curler, Baker, Sullivan and Abel, and President Clark. Absent: Regent O'Brien.

Mr. Curler reported for the committee named to look into the claim of Dr. James for \$600 for Summer School, as follows:

That in accordance with the understanding of the Board of Regents [REDACTED]
at the meeting on Tuesday, Chairman Abel and myself yesterday
(May 8) called on Mr. Price, of the firm Cheney, Price and
Hawkins, with respect to the claim of Dr. Barnes. We found the

derstanding of the Board, as we gathered it, that he (Dr. James) was not to have \$600 unless he held a Summer School, and as he did not hold a Summer School in 1915, he was not entitled to the \$600.

After a more or less protracted discussion, which went into a construction of the letters and telegrams which passed between the President of the University and Dr. James, we concluded that the legal contention of Mr. Price would probably be upheld in the courts, and Mr. Abel will join me in saying that it is t
