Lowell Daniels House for the President

In view of the fact that the bequest of Lowell Daniels made possible the purchase of a home for the President,

Motion by Mr. Thompson carried unanimously that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, Lowell Daniels, a worthy citizen of Nevada, named the University of Nevada as one of his beneficiaries,

WHEREAS, \$60,000 of this gift was used by the Board of Regents to purchase a residence for the President of the University of Nevada at 1080 Mount Rose Street in Reno.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this residence be known as the Lowell Daniels House for the President of the University.

The meeting adjourned at 11 A.M.

Regents Hardy, Thompson, Lombardi and Ross then joined the President and party to go to Carson City for a meeting with Governor Russell concerning the University's needs and their inclusion on the agenda for a special session of the Legislature.
