
A student may be dismissed from a program for academic reasons which may include but are not limited to inadequate grades or failure to remain in academic good standing as defined by the program, a lack of professionalism or unethical conduct, or failure to comply with other specific program requirements. Failure to comport with professional and/or ethical standards applicable to the particular discipline or program may be grounds for dismissal from a program. "Program" includes but is not limited to all undergraduate and graduate programs which have special requirements for admission to and/or for progression within the particular program. If the program has special requirements for admission or progression they must be in writing and either published on the institution's website or provided in writing to all students who are admitted to the program.
