Report on Sexual Violence Data, Trends, and Services Available

Campus Climate Survey Spring 2019

- Most respondents strongly agreed with the statement “I feel safe at GBC.”
- Just over 8% reported having a friend/acquaintance who was a victim of an unwanted sexual experience.
- 4.3% believed they had witnessed a situation that could lead to a sexual assault.
- 12.7% reported experiencing or witnessing sexual harassment
- Most of the respondents reported they had not experienced any forms of interpersonal violence while they were a student at GBC.
- 7.9% of respondents reported being the victim of any form of unwanted sexual encounter while attending GBC. (Note: because of the smaller number of students at GBC it should be noted this report was from 11 respondents.)
- Most respondents reported their assault took place off the GBC campus. 65% reported that it had occurred two years ago or more.

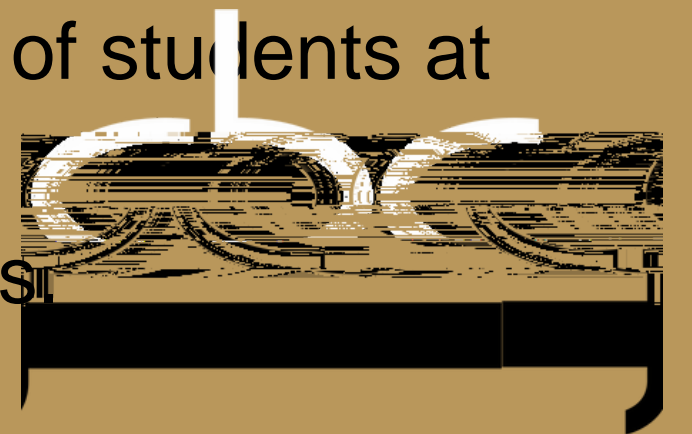

Campus Climate Survey Spring 2022

- Most respondents strongly agreed with the statement “I feel safe at GBC.”
- 2% reported having a friend/acquaintance who was a victim of an unwanted sexual experience.
- 2.2% believed they had witnessed a situation that could lead to a sexual assault.
- 33.3% reported intervening when they experienced witnessing behavior that may lead to sexual harassment.
- Most respondents reported they had not experienced any forms of interpersonal violence while they were a student at GBC.
- 7.9% of respondents reported being the victim of any form of unwanted sexual encounter while attending GBC. (Note: because of the smaller number of students at GBC it should be noted this report was from 11 respondents.)
- Most respondents reported their assault took place off the GBC campus.
